# Request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 1982 for access to documents

I refer to your request for access to documents under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1982 dated 6 February 2017.

Your request seeks access to the following documents:

ASIC generated document or by third party, information showing what is being done in Australia to keep track of the number of suicides caused by financial fraud.

I am the authorised decision-maker for the purposes of section 23 of the Act and this letter gives notice of my decision.

#### The Decision

#### Section 24A of the FOI Act

### Section 24A(1) of the FOI Act states:

An agency or Minister may refuse a request for access to a document if:

- (a) all reasonable steps have been taken to find the document; and
- (b) the agency or Minister is satisfied that the document:
  - is in the agency's or Minister's possession but cannot be found;
    or
  - ii. does not exist.

In processing your request I have made enquiries of all relevant ASIC teams who may be in possession of the types of documents sought in your request.

The above enquiries have revealed no documents within the scope of your request.

I am satisfied that all reasonable steps have been taken to locate documents relevant to your request and I am satisfied that the documents either cannot be found or do not exist. I have therefore decided to refuse your request pursuant to s 24A(1) of the FOI Act.

## Review Rights

In the event that you are dissatisfied with the decision:

- You may, within 30 days after the day on which you have been notified of this decision, apply in writing to ASIC for a review of my decision by another ASIC officer under section 54B of the FOI Act. This request should be addressed to me or to the Senior Manager, Administrative Law GPO Box 9827 SYDNEY or by email to foirequest@asic.gov.au
- You may within 60 days after the day on which you have been notified of this decision, apply in writing to the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC) for a review of my decision under section 54N of the FOI Act. - You may lodge a complaint with the OAIC in relation to the conduct of ASIC in the handling of this request. You may contact the OAIC as described above.
